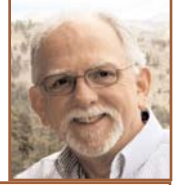

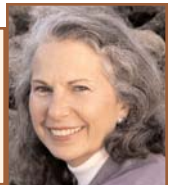
## Writing on Samaritan Walls . . . God's Heart for the Muslim World - David Compton
